

## ***Road Directions to Edinburgh Royal Infirmary at Little France***

The Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh is located at Little France on Old Dalkeith Road (A7) on the south side of Edinburgh.

### ***Directions from City Centre:***

- leave the City centre via North Bridge at the east end of Princes Street
- follow this road for about 2 miles taking the first exit (left) at the major junction with Liberton Road and Lady Road
- at small roundabout go straight over to next roundabout (with traffic lights) at Cameron Toll
- take the third exit onto Old Dalkeith Road (A7)
- turn left into the hospital after three quarters of a mile (use South entrance - the second you come to from the city)

### ***Directions from City Bypass:***

- leave the Edinburgh City Bypass (A720) at the Sheriffhall Roundabout onto Old Dalkeith Road (A7) (follow Hospital signs)
- turn right into the hospital after just over 2 miles (use South entrance - the first you come to from bypass)

### ***Car Parking:***

There are traffic lights controlling both hospital entrances. Use the South Entrance and follow the signs to **Car Park C** towards the rear of the hospital building.

This is a visitor car park and the current charges are: -

- 0-1 hour £1.20
- 1-2 hours £2.20
- 2-3 hours £3.20
- 3-4 hours £4.10
- 4-5 hours £5.30
- 5-6 hours £6.50
- 6-24 hours £10.00
